### 1. Introduction

Pahalwan Gurudeen Prashikshan Mahavidyalaya strictly prohibits ragging in any form within the campus and affiliated facilities. The institution follows the provisions laid down by the University Grants Commission under the **UGC Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions (Second Amendment) Regulations, 2013**.

The college is committed to providing a safe, respectful, and supportive learning environment for all students. Ragging is considered a serious offense and any act of ragging will invite strict disciplinary action as per UGC norms.

### 2. What is Ragging?

As defined by the University Grants Commission regulations, **ragging** includes any act that causes or is likely to cause physical, psychological, or emotional harm, embarrassment, or harassment to a student.

Examples include:

- Physical or verbal abuse
- Teasing, bullying, or intimidation
- Forcing students to perform humiliating acts
- Harassment or discrimination
- Any act affecting the mental or physical well-being of a student

Ragging in any form, whether inside or outside the campus, is strictly prohibited.

### 3. Objectives of the Anti-Ragging Policy

The main objectives of the Anti-Ragging Policy are:

1. To prevent ragging in the institution.
2. To create a friendly and supportive academic environment.

- Monitoring of student behaviour by faculty members and staff

## 7. Punishments for Ragging

Any student found guilty of ragging will face disciplinary action as per the regulations of the University Grants Commission.

Possible punishments may include:

- Suspension from classes

- Cancellation of admission
- Expulsion from the institution
- Filing of a police complaint where necessary

## 8. Complaint Procedure

Students facing ragging or witnessing such incidents may report the matter immediately.

- Email to the official college email ID
- Online complaint through the college website

All complaints will be treated confidentially and appropriate action will be taken promptly.
